Other region of responsibility includes, to include, most of Southeast Asia, the Far East, and the north Pacific Ocean. In the Asia-Pacific region, the most significant events include the Vietnam War (1964-1975), the Korean War (1950-53), the Korean War Armistice Agreements (1950, 1953), the First Indochina War (1946-54), the Second Indochina War (1946-54), and the Vietnam War (1954-75), and many other smaller but significant events. The Secretary of the Navy's duties include: supervising the various Navy commands, the Board of Inspection and Survey, and the Office of the Chief of Naval Operations; approving the Navy Budget for the current fiscal year; providing advice and recommendations to the President and Congress with respect to national defense, the national foreign policy, the development of plans for the use and production of defense resources, and manpower requirements; and preparing the fleet for possible combat operations or operations of other strategic importance, participating in the conduct of international relations, and providing for naval personnel, except for those in the command, staff, and senior civilian positions who are clearly identified with specific responsibilities and commitments for the conduct of combat operations. The Secretary of the Air Force's duties include: supervising the various Air Force commands, the activities of the National Military Command Center, the Office of the Secretary of Defense, and the various services of the Air Force, and advising and consulting with the President and Congress with respect to national defense, the national foreign policy, the development of plans for the use and production of defense resources, and manpower requirements; and participating in the conduct of international relations. The Secretary of the Army's duties include: supervising the various Army commands, the development of plans and programs for the use of defense resources, and advising and consulting with the President and Congress with respect to national defense, the national foreign policy, the development of plans for the use and production of defense resources, and manpower requirements; and providing for military personnel, except for those in the command, staff, and senior civilian positions who are clearly identified with specific responsibilities and commitments for the conduct of combat operations.
